
"We met a Roman soldier who was telling us how lesus got out of the tomb. He was lying at first but told the truth

If the headache is more severe and is accompanied by other symptoms such as a raised temperature or drowsiness, keep your child at home and consult your GP.

Rashes can be the first sign of infectious illnesses. If your child has a rash, please check with your GP before sending them to school.

Vomiting and diarrhoea.

Children can return to school 48 hours after symptoms have subsided.
